## GOD'S MAJESTY

*We prepare our hearts to worship in silence and stillness as we come into God's holy presence.*

*Family:* The LORD is high above all nations, and his glory above the heavens!

*Together:* who looks far down on the heavens and the earth?

## CONFESSION OF FAITH\*

### Westminster Shorter Catechism, Questions 5-6

Q. 5. Is there more than one God?

A. There is only one, the living and true God.

Q. 6. How many persons are in the one God?

A. Three persons are in the one God, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are one God, the same in substance and equal in power and glory.

## GOD'S MERCY

*Beholding God, we become aware of our sin and how we fall short of his glory. We respond with corporate and individual prayers of confession in view of God's infinite mercy.*

### PRAYER OF CONFESSION\*

*Adapted from The Valley of Vision, "Divine Mercies"*

Eternal God, O, how I mourn my sin and all the days that add to my guilt. All things in heaven, earth, around, within and without, condemn me—the sun which sees my misdeeds, the cruel accuser who justly charges me, your face which scans my secret sins, your righteous law and holy Word which expose my heart's true condition. I deny them not and present no excuse, but confess, 'Father, I have sinned.' As I run to your outstretched arms, you will not cast me off, for Jesus brings me near. You will not condemn me, for he died in my stead. O God, I bid farewell to sin by clinging to his cross, hiding in his wounds, and sheltering in his side.

# PRIVATE CONFESSION OF SIN\*

*God responds to us with an assurance that we have been forgiven freely and entirely in Jesus Christ by grace through faith.*

## ASSURANCE OF PARDON\*

Romans 8:31-35

*Leader:* What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword?
