CONFESSION OF FAITH*

Westminster Shorter Catechism, Questions 57-58

Q. 57. What is the fourth commandment?

A: The fourth commandment is: “Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates. For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.”

Q. 58. What is required in the fourth commandment?

A: The fourth commandment requires us to set apart to God the times he has established in his word, specifically one whole day out of every seven, as a holy Sabbath to him.
