Confession of Faith*

Westminster Shorter Catechism, Questions 59-60

Q. 59. Which day of the week has God appointed to be the weekly Sabbath?

A. From the beginning of the world to the resurrection of Christ, God appointed the seventh day of the week to be the weekly Sabbath; from that time until the end of the world, the first day of the week is the Christian Sabbath.

Q. 60. How are we to keep the Sabbath holy?

A. We keep the Sabbath holy by resting the whole day, even from worldly employments and recreations that are lawful on other days; and spending the whole time in the public and private worship of God, except for works of necessity and mercy.
