CONFESSION OF FAITH*

Westminster Shorter Catechism, Questions 67-69

Q. 67. What is the sixth commandment?

A. The sixth commandment is: You shall not murder.

Q. 68. What is required in the sixth commandment?

A. The sixth commandment requires that we make every lawful effort to preserve our own life and the lives of others.

Q. 69. What is forbidden in the sixth commandment?

A. The sixth commandment forbids us from taking our own life, or the life of our neighbor unjustly, or doing anything that leads to suicide or murder.
