CONFESSION OF FAITH*

Westminster Shorter Catechism, Questions 85-86

Q. 85. What does God require from us to escape his wrath and curse, which we deserve for our sin?

A. To escape God's wrath and curse, which we deserve for our sin, God requires from us faith in Jesus Christ and repentance unto life, along with the diligent use of all the outward means by which Christ brings to us the benefits of redemption.

Q. 86. What is faith in Jesus Christ?

A. Faith in Jesus Christ is a saving grace, by which we receive and rest on him alone for salvation, as he is offered to us in the gospel.

Ephesians 2:1-10
