Out of Darkness is the anti-trafficking ministry of Atlanta Dream Center, Inc., a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization. Out of Darkness Middle Georgia is the first chapter affiliated with the Atlanta Out of Darkness ministry. Out of Darkness Middle Georgia is focused on reaching victims of the sex trafficking industry in the Macon-Warner Robins and surrounding Middle Georgia counties.

Our mission is to reach, rescue and restore victims of commercial sexual exploitation, that the glory of God may be known.

Our vision is for Middle Georgia to be known as a place of restoration where every woman is living free.

Our purpose and passion is to love the broken (Isaiah 61:1-3).

GET STARTED IMMEDIATELY

Princess Night and Adopt-a-Block are ways to get involved immediately. This is the best introduction to Out of Darkness Middle Georgia. These volunteer opportunities are always open and do not require additional training to participate. Princess Night: Every day, women and young girls in Middle Georgia sell their bodies to survive. Princess Night is a ministry of Out of Darkness and focuses on breaking the cycle of sex-trafficking. Several Friday evenings each month, Princess Night volunteers share a message of God's love, hope, and restoration. Volunteers meet at 8:00 p.m. After training and prayer, we go to areas of street prostitution to hand out roses and handwritten cards of encouragement and scripture. We let the ladies know that they are loved and beautiful, and ask if there is anything we can pray with them about. This is a time we ensure they receive our 24/7 hot line phone number that they can call anytime to be rescued.

Adopt-a-Block: A ministry of Out of Darkness, Adopt-a-block takes place the last Saturday of the month, following a Princess Night. Volunteers share a message of God's love, hope, and restoration with every precious man, woman or child that we encounter by visiting hotels and other areas where trafficking takes place. Our outreach team gives them hot line contact information, toiletries and other essential items.

ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

The following ministry opportunities require additional training to serve.

Jail Outreach: Most women caught up in the life of prostitution will be arrested at some point in their lives. For many, this will be the only way out. If help is requested, Out of darkness will visit on a weekly basis, and upon release, that individual will have the opportunity to come and begin the journey of healing. Volunteer recommended minimum age is 21 years of age for both men and women volunteers, but individuals 18 and older will be considered. Must be able to commit to at least twice per month for jail visitations. *(Need more details? Contact Beverly Ulrich, beverlyulrich76@gmail.com.)*

Hot Line Team: We operate a 24/7 rescue hot line that can be called any time day or night by anyone wanting help leaving "the life." The hot line system that we use takes the calls that come into our hot line and re-routes them to the cell phones of women who volunteer as hot line responders. Volunteer recommended minimum age is 18 years of age, and this team is for women only. *(Need more details? Contact Denise Lester, cdlester1@gmail.com.)*

Rescue Team: We operate a 24/7 rescue hot line that can be called any time day or night by anyone wanting help leaving "the life." Once a call is received, our Hot Line Team Responders coordinate a Rescue Team to go pick the caller up in a safe meeting location and transport to one of our safe homes. Volunteer recommended minimum age is 21-years-old, and this team is for **men and women**. *(Need more details? Contact Denise Lester, cdlester1@gmail.com.)*
