BIG IDEA

Jesus doesn't just want to be our Savior. He also wants to be our King.

Message title: Born To Reign

Scripture Reading: Luke 2:1-5, Matthew 2:1-7 NIV

Jesus didn't come just to forgive sins or promise heaven someday. He came to establish a new kind of kingdom here and now and to invite us to be a part of it.

- 1. Are you someone who keeps Christmas decorations up for as long as possible or takes them down on the day after Christmas?
- 2. How does the understanding that Jesus was born a King and not a Savior challenge how you think about Him?
- 3. Why do you think so many people prefer the idea of Jesus as Savior to the idea that Jesus is King?
- 4. What does choosing Jesus as King look like practically in your day-to-day decisions, habits, relationships or priorities?
- 5. If Jesus' Kingdom is "for this world" and not just the next, what would it look like if our lives more fully reflected Kingdom values?

This week, identify one specific area where you've kept Jesus in the category of "Savior" but not "King." And then take one concrete action that aligns with His Kingdom rather than your convenience or culture's expectations.
