## **BIG IDEA**

Patience has the power to transform communities.

Message title: Enviable Patience

Scripture Reading: Acts 17:2-8, 1 Thessalonians 5: 14-15 NIV

The fruit of the spirit are often interconnected because practicing one often helps us better develop the others. Losing patience is often the result of an unaddressed fear or concern.
