The First and Second Half of the Gospel. I urge everyone to go to the following link https://vimeo.com/77166888 and watch this fiveminute video presentation by J.D. Walt of Seedbed presenting the information taken from a survey done by the George Barna organization. The survey was done over a 6-year period, with direct telephone contacts with 15k people in North America surveying their spiritual faith. Barna found people tend to find themselves at one of ten different transformational stops. It is very informative when you see were Americans fall across the spectrum. It seems clear that we are going halfway, but not the other half. It was John Wesley who wrote: "Christian perfection [sanctification] is the grand depositum which God had lodged with the people called Methodist; and for the sake of propagating this chiefly He appeared to have raised us up."

"Again—the big idea—when the church wakes up to the second half of the gospel, the world will wake up to the first half of the gospel. And then we will be ready to lead them into the fullness of the second half. It makes sense, doesn't it? Continued Page 2...

I continue to be honored to serve on the ONE DAY OF HOPE BOARD and we are pleased to announce the date for the ONE DAY OF HOPE EVENT, 2023. Please see the following from our Board Chairperson, Ray Marcrom:

"After two years of working around the pandemic which prevented us from having an annual big event, 2022 was a wonderful cooperative effort... through the results of that effort, we served approximately 2000 guests with over 300 volunteers.

This year our event will be held on **OCTOBER** 7, 2023, at Coffee County Fairgrounds. Additionally, we have raised support for a facility called the HOPE CENTER which has allowed us to begin a weekly Medical Clinic for the uninsured through cooperation with Partners for Healing. We also plan to allow the Coffee County Health Department to provide services using this clinic beginning this summer. We also anticipate providing other ongoing services which we now do only at the annual event. Of course, all of these programs will need your support and volunteer efforts as well. We will keep you posted!"
