Meet Pastor Michael Cobb:



Rev. Michael Cobb was born May 26, 1972, in Montgomery, AL. His father was in the U.S. Air Force, so they moved around a lot during his early years until he and his family ended up moving from Washington, D.C. and Warrenton, VA back to Montgomery, AL.

There, Michael became heavily involved with the Frazer Memorial UMC Youth program, where his faith was solidified and grown. During his college years, Michael assisted the Frazer Youth program and took many short and intermediate term mission trips to Ecuador, Brazil, Mexico, with two longer term trips to Juneau, AK and Guatemala. Michael knew he had a call on his life, but because of his Catholic upbringing, felt unworthy of the call. Thus, he finished Auburn University at Montgomery with two undergraduate degrees and a Master of Finance and ended up in the investment industry.

During this period, he was teaching the largest Sunday school class at Frazer. But at the onset of self-directed day trading platforms with an upheaval in the stock market due to Enron, Michael left the investment industry and started a home renovations company with his younger brother, Matthew, and his cousin, Joshua, all the while remaining actively involved in missions, Sunday school, starting small groups, mentoring exfelons and those with addictive disease, also serving in leadership with Frazer Memorial UMC's administrative council.

In 2009, Michael and Amanda began praying about next steps and after speaking with several mentors, he decided to enter candidacy in the UMC and enter Asbury Theological Seminary. He pastored Hardwicks Creek UMC in Clay City, KY during his seminary years. After graduation, he was appointed as Associate Pastor to St. Luke UMC in Pensacola, Fl, then to Allen Memorial UMC in Cantonment, Fl, and finally the last 8 years he has been serving Dalraida Global Methodist, leading them through several renovation projects and disaffiliation in 2022. Michael was officially ordained in the Global Methodist Church on December 22, 2022.
