A Call to Prayer: Each morning at 4 a.m., John Wesley would kneel in prayer in his London home. It was in this place that the fires of Methodism began. As we fan the Spiritual fires of spreading scriptural holiness for the Great Awakening, there is not a better place to begin than with prayer. Perhaps not at 4 a.m., but sometime during each day. So, let's join the entirety of the peoples of the GMC in daily and specific prayer for each day of the week for a Month beginning on August 1 until the end of the month.

Sunday: Give thanks to the Father for the gift of forgiveness and pardon through Christ. (Ephesians 2:8-9)

Monday: Ask the Lord to reveal to you any places where you have departed from the way of holy love and ask for the Holy Spirit to enable you to return to the way of holy love. (1 John 1:9)

Tuesday: Pray for the leaders of our movement to be captured by holy love and freed from "love of the world, the love of pleasure, of ease, of honour, of money." (1 John 2:15-17)

Wednesday: Pray for God to open doors for you to share God's holy love with others. (Mark 16:15)

Thursday: Thank the Lord for all of the faithful witnesses to holy love God has raised up who provide examples for us to learn from and follow. (Hebrews 12:1-2)

Friday: Reflect on God's perfect love for you and ask the Father to help you receive his holy love more deeply. (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24)

Saturday: Ask God to revive the people called Methodists. (Psalm 85:4-7)

A Suggested Pattern of Prayer: As you pray through the following prayer points, invite the presence of the Lord into your time of prayer. Each day's prompt has a Scripture reference for you to pray through. As you pray also allow time to listen to what the Holy Spirit is saying to you. When you have prayed through the Scripture and prayer point, you may be led to add your own prayers. Pray and consider what action steps you might take in response to the Lord's leading. Repeat this prayer pattern weekly for the month.

Wake up sleeper and rise from the dead, And Christ will Shine on you!

May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had, so that with one mind and one voice you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 15:5-6 (NIV)

To be of the same attitude of mind individually and as a church requires a double work of the Holy Spirit. Both from the outside and from the inside – a presentation of the holy truth of God from the outside and then the breaking of the hard heart that blinds and corrupts the mind.

As Kevin Watson points out, "the church is addicted to curriculum, and it is not adding up to transformational living." The outward study and presentation of the holy truth of God via scripture and other sources does not yield by itself the "same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had...". The outward work of the Holy Spirit must be combined with the inward work of the Holy Spirit.

To move forward in your/our transformation as a Christian takes other Christians. Transformational faith is a team sport:

takes other Christians. Transformational faith is a team sport; so, the saying in the early church: One Christian—no Christian. This is why we get stuck in repetitive sin patterns and habits that trouble us for years. Hearing the truth, but not sharing in the Words' power. In fact, we know what we need to do to go forward from our history of success — we need to Band. Banding is not anything new... just forgotten. Bands are an instrument that the Holy Spirit uses powerfully to transform us from the inside.
