Oct 26 — Revere His Holiness (Isaiah 6)

Welcome & Ice Breaker:

O What images come to your mind when you hear the word holiness? What is the holiest place you have been to or visited? What made it holy? How have you experienced the holiness of God in your life? When was it? What was it like? How did that encounter leave you? How did it impact your life afterwards?

• Opening Prayers:

- O Hold yourself before the Lord // Psalm 139:23
 - What emotions are you feeling as you come to Life Group?
 - Hold all of yourself out to Him and sit quietly Allow God to come close to you & care for you in prayer right now Listen for His voice/presence/leading
- o Hold what you are holding before the Lord // Psalm 90:17
 - What are you dealing with, working on, preparing for?
 - Hold it out to Him and sit quietly Allow God to come close to you & establish the work of your hands Listen for His voice/presence/leading
- o Return Recommit Repent Reattach to the LORD who is with you // Psalm 139:24
 - Draw near to God as He draws near to you
 - "...I acquiesce to You Abba Father, to work and pray and seek Your own through me"

• Scripture Passage: Isaiah 6

- o Begin by reading the passage out loud; even a few times if it is a shorter passage in order to let it settle down inside you.
- o As the Scripture is being read, pay attention to any word, phrase, or feeling that the Holy Spirit may be highlighting to you.
- o Then share what you noticed and/or write down your observations as the Spirit leads.

•	0	Discussion/Personal Reflection What challenged you, or stood out to you during your devotional time with the Lord Jesus this week?
	0	If you were able to hear it, what did the Holy Spirit point out to you personally from Sunday's sermon?
	0	Know: God is Holy. He is different from his creation. In what ways is God different from His creation: all-knowing, all-powerful, all-goodness? Read Jeremiah 29:11 and Jeremiah 17:5-8 and Proverbs 3:5-6. Why can we put our trust in God?
	0	Grow: What worship songs has God highlighted for you in this season of your life? (Amazing grace, Hard Fought Hallelujah, Praise Him Anywhere, Ever Be, etc.)? Read Psalm 100:1. Why is music and worship music so powerful in different seasons of our lives?
	0	Go: In Isaiah 6, the prophet desperately needed a vision of God during political upheaval in his time. He encounters God and gets his special assignment to serve God's people. Read Isaiah 52:7. Have you received a special assignment from God that has clarified your role in society, at church, in your life group? (Examples:

special assignment from God that has clarified your role in society, at church, in your life group? (Examples: teachers calling to shape the hearts and minds of kids to enjoy God's beauty and learn about how our minds can learn things, or plumbers learn that we need to live in clean environments where piping and tubing need to take dirty water out of our homes into the systems the cities put in place or stay-at-home moms provide a space where her kids and her family can love and serve one another and her high calling is to make her kids know who they are in God's eyes, and how God has uniquely wired them for a purpose, and they can love others with the wild heart of God.)
