Experiencing the joy and wonder God's great gift of Jesus this December along with you,



GIFTS FOR VICTIMS OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Our church partners with Waymakers, a non-profit organization that supports victims of human trafficking. This Christmas season, you are invited to help by purchasing gifts for the victims and their family members that Waymakers and the Salvation Army are assisting.

The Christmas tree in the lobby has silver stars with the names of people in need. Would you consider taking a star and buying gifts for them?


Here is what we ask of you:

- r Please purchase the items from their wish list found on the back of the star ornament. If you would like to purchase other items after the wish list is fulfilled, that would be great! Some don't have a list pray and purchase as you will.
- r We ask that your present costs between \$20 − \$50.
- r Wrap your items and put them in a <u>HOLIDAY</u> gift bag not a Christmasy one. For example, bags of any color; with snowmen or stars, or with Christmas trees and outdoor scenes. Please don't use bags that say "Merry Christmas" or have a scene depicting the nativity.
- r The gift bags MUST be turned in at church <u>no later than Tuesday, Dec. 5</u> the earlier, the better!!!
- ▶ When the present is ready to be turned in to the church, please tape the star name tag/ornament on the bag or we won't know who to give it to! And take their wish list off the back of it.
- r Feel free to add a personal note of encouragement or holiday cheer.
- r Pray for the person you are buying for!!
- r Thank you so much for doing this and making a huge difference in someone's life.







Lisa R: If you would like to get into the Word, want to feel welcome and fellowship with a small group of women of various ages, and wonder what's happening at Neighborhood Church when it's not Sunday, stop in at room 2 on Thursdays at 9:30a.

We have been spending several weeks looking at the beginning of 1 Timothy as Paul is preparing Timothy to go out to the churches to continue the work Paul has begun which is to carry the good news and instruct the people. Timothy is young and must beware of false teachers. Our women have learned to question who today's false teachers might be, as well as how to use great care in how we study the Word, and pass along instruction to our children. Timothy is instructed in the functions of the elders and deacons of the church who are totally different from the power wielding Pharisees of their day. Our group discussions, prayer and praise time have been transformational as we consider our church life today. We have also had great discussions about the role of women in our homes and community, how to support our husbands, sons, and pastors as encouragers and examples since we are the church.

1 Timothy is a small but mighty book and we can't wait to get back from Christmas break to see where our study will lead us next!

There's always room for you in room 2 so don't hesitate to join us after the New Year when we continue our study of 1 Timothy on Thursday, January 10, 2024.
