The Power of Connection

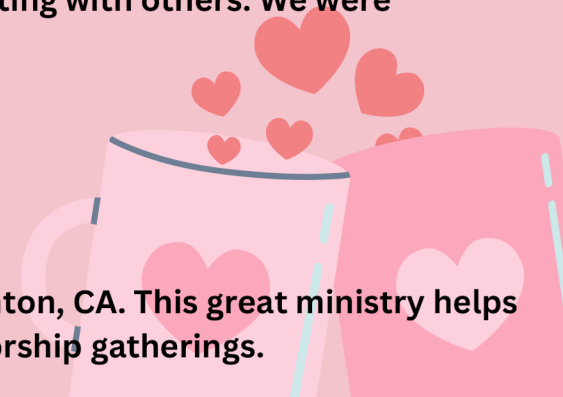
This February marks one year that Coffee Connect has been up and running. In Psalms 133:1 it reads that it is good and pleasant to dwell in unity, and Acts 2:42 reads that they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread (donuts are pretty similar) and to prayer. There is just something about being around others that brings us closer and even brings ministering. I have had the privilege of meeting new people, prayed with other believers and have made some amazing new friendships.

On December 23, 2023, my husband's aunt passed away at the age of 98. She lived a good, long life and she was a true testimony of God's love. Every year, she would paint or draw us a card whether it was for a birthday or anniversary....every year...without fail. When our daughters came along, she did the same for them. When we broke the news to the girls about Aunt June going to be with Jesus, they were sad and tears were shed. Needless to say, this Christmas was a little heavy for us. But praise God that we know we have that hope of seeing her again in Glory.

Then, on December 24, a beautiful woman I met through Coffee Connect handed me a Christmas card. My initial thought was how sweet of her, she didn't have to do that. When I opened the card, I couldn't believe it. I pulled out a hand painted Christmas card and the tears immediately welled up in my eyes as her kind gesture had ministered to my heart. God can use a card, a cup of coffee or a donut to meet us where we are - we just have to be present.

I know we are past January, and maybe you aren't into making New Year's resolutions... but this could be a year where you try to be more intentional in connecting with others. We were just meant to be together.

HOW TO LIVE MISSIONALLY?

As we seek to live missionally this year, Neighborhood Los Al has been looking to give handles to missional living.

Surprise the World! by Michael Frost shares “five habits of highly missional people.” It’s easy to remember them with the acronym B.E.L.L.S.

B is for Bless. We bless people by sharing a word of encouragement or doing an act of kindness for them. This helps us to learn to live beyond ourselves.

E is for Eat. How great is this?! Breaking bread can be a great way to live on mission. Most of us eat 21 times per week (or so). Try to include those outside your household in three of those meals. Try to make at least one of those meals with someone from the church family and another with someone who doesn’t yet know Jesus. Grab a bite and let the relationship develop.

L is for Listen to the Holy Spirit. A missional life is a life of responding to the Holy Spirit’s leading. Take some time to listen to Him and write down what you think He may be saying.

L is for Learn Jesus. We want to become like Jesus, which means we need to know Him more clearly and, as we do, we will grow to love Him more deeply. Take some time to draw nearer to Jesus through the Scriptures. What are you learning?

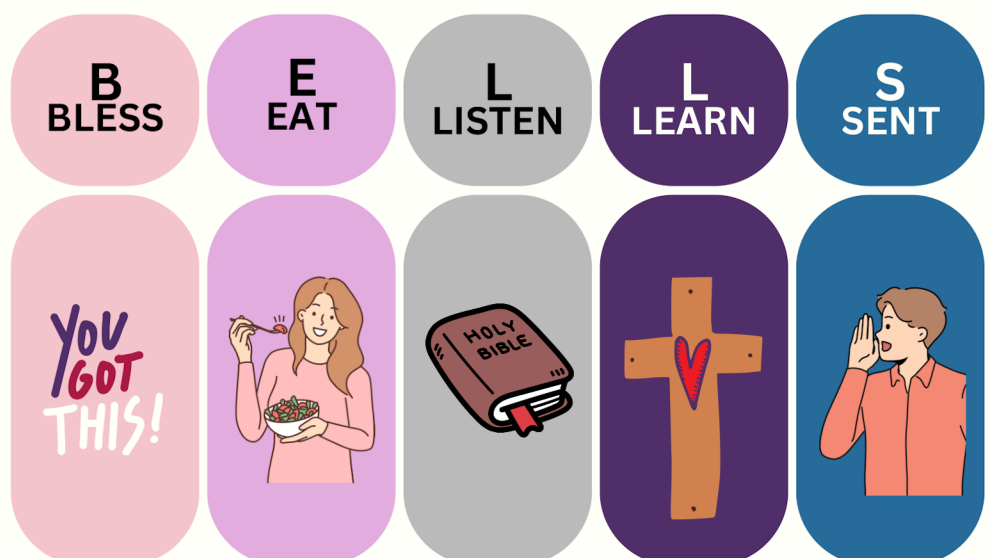
S is for Sent. We are sent to testify of God’s goodness. Tell someone about Jesus and how much He loves them. Point people to God’s mercy, justice, and/or beauty.

Each week we encourage one another to pick one of the BELLS practices and do it in the name of the Lord with three people (1. to someone at church 2. to someone outside the church and 3. to anyone else the Lord might highlight).

For example, one week we picked BLESS. Share a word of encouragement to someone in your Life Group, to someone in your neighborhood, and maybe a coworker.

We hope you are encouraged to live out God’s mission where God has placed you.

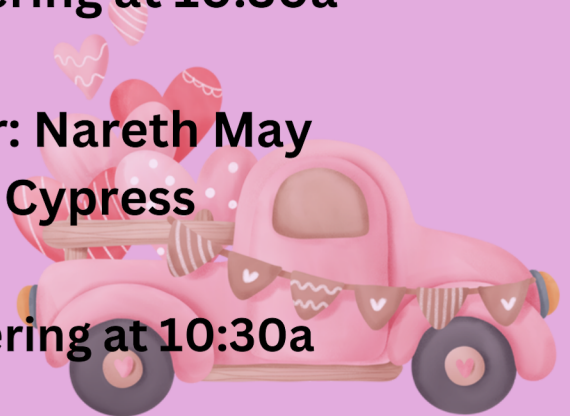
