The Apostle Paul puts it like this: "You were taught, with regard to your former way of life, to put off your old self, which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires; to be made new in the attitude of your minds; and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness." Ephesians 4:22-24 NIV

Lent is an invitation to experience a personal resurrection to new life. It is an invitation to taste in a new and exciting way the life Christ offers in this world and promises in the world to come. I pray that each of us will accept God's invitation through the Lent to grow in love and grace with Him.


