“Blessed to Be a Blessing”

June 28, 2026

Luke 12:35-48: "From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded."

Opening Question: How will you celebrate the 4th of July?

As Americans, we often speak of how blessed we are:

Freedom, Opportunity, Resources, Security, & Faith

The question is not simply, "Have we been blessed?"

The question is, "What are we doing with those blessings?"

God's pattern has always been that people are blessed in order to be a blessing!

God Owns Everything We Have

In Luke 12, the servant is not the owner. He is a steward.

Everything we have belongs ultimately to God. This is true at every level – individually, as a congregation, and as a county.

We are managers, not owners. Psalm 24:

"The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it."

How am I stewarding what God has entrusted to me?

Am I using my blessings only for myself?

Greater Blessing Brings Greater Responsibility

The Bible teaches that privilege comes with responsibility.

Abraham blessed to bless nations (Genesis 12:2-3)

Israel blessed to be a light to the world (Isaiah 49:6)

The Church blessed to make disciples (Matthew 28:19-20)

America has been greatly blessed:

Economic abundance

Religious freedom

Educational opportunity

Global influence

These blessings are not merely for our comfort.

The greater the blessing, the greater the stewardship.

God Blesses Us So Others Can Flourish

Genesis 12:2 "I will bless you ... and you will be a blessing."

God's blessings were never meant to stop with us.

God's blessings are channels, not reservoirs.

We should be grateful for God's blessings on our lives and on our nation. But gratitude must lead to stewardship.

The question is not: "How blessed am I?"

The question is: "How am I using God's blessings to bless others?"
