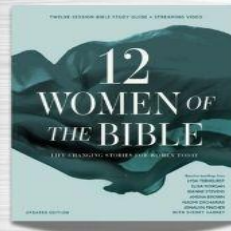


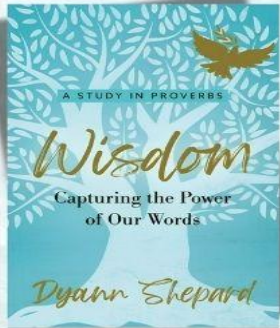

Opening Question for small groups: Do you have any big plans for summer? (“Big” could be anything!)

Scripture: Genesis 1:26 *Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over [g]all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.”* 27 *So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.*

As America approaches its 250th birthday, we celebrate one of the most powerful statements ever written in a political document:

*We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.*

Those words from the Declaration of Independence did not appear out of nowhere. They reflect a truth that had already been declared thousands of years earlier in Scripture. The foundation for human equality is not government, wealth, race, education, or social status. The foundation is that every person is made in the image of God.

Prayer: Heavenly Father, thank You for creating every person in Your image and giving each life dignity and value. As we celebrate our nation's 250th birthday, help us honor You by loving our neighbors, defending the worth of every person, and pointing people to the saving grace found in Jesus Christ. Amen.

### **We Share the Same Divine Creator**

The Bible begins with a revolutionary truth. Every human being traces their origin to the same Creator. In the ancient world, kings claimed divine status while common people were treated as less valuable. Scripture shattered that idea. God did not place His image on a select few. He placed His image on all humanity.

Our equality does not come from government. It comes from God.

Do we strive to treat all people as image-bearers of God?

### **We Share the Same God-Given Dignity**

The Declaration of Independence speaks of unalienable rights. The biblical reason those rights exist is because human beings possess God-given dignity.

This truth fueled many of the great movements for justice and human rights throughout history. Christians opposed slavery, built hospitals, started schools, and cared for the vulnerable because they believed every person mattered to God.

### **We Share the Same Need for Redemption**

The image of God remains in humanity, but sin has damaged what God intended. The greatest equality in Scripture is not merely that we were all created by God. It is that we all need a Savior.

At the foot of the cross, every person stands on equal ground.

Have you received Christ as Savior?
