Matthew 6:9-13

6:10 Your kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

Review: Jesus teaches us to pray because on our own we do not know how to pray effectively. Prayer teaches God's relationship, eternal reign, and complete holiness.

This week:
