The Lord's Prayer: Matthew 6:9-13

6:13 And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one.

Review: Jesus teaches us to pray because on our own we do not know how to pray effectively. Prayer teaches God's relationship, eternal reign, and complete holiness. Prayer commits us to the vision of the Kingdom of God and a contentment with what we have and the need to experience forgiveness personally that we then extend to others.

This week:

Jesus prepares us for temptation

Jesus experienced temptation (Matthew 4:1) and models prayer as preparation. When we are Hungry, Angry, Lonely, or Tired (HALT) we are most vulnerable (Matthew 26:41).

Jesus' prayer pursues the Deliverer

We pray for God's ultimate salvation, not just our own strength. The spiritual battle is real. We have a Savior who has been tempted (Hebrews 4:15) and yet lived a perfect life.

God leads us, His Word strengthens us, and Christ has already faced the tempter and won.
