6 Weeks of Prayer - July 19 – August 23

Matthew 6:9-13

6:11 Give us today our daily bread.

Review: Jesus teaches us to pray because on our own we do not know how to pray effectively. Prayer teaches God's relationship, eternal reign, and complete holiness. Prayer commits us to the vision of the Kingdom of God.

This week:

Our Father Supplies our physical needs.
