"Temptation and How Jesus Wins"

Luke 4 & The Screwtape Letters, 1-5

In Luke's Gospel, Satan confronts Jesus directly. In the fictional The Screwtape Letters, demons work quietly, patiently, and secretly.

"There are two equal and opposite errors... to disbelieve in their (demons) existence, or to feel an excessive and unhealthy interest in them."

– C.S. Lewis

Temptation confuses identity with legitimate needs

Luke 4:3 "If You are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread."

Jesus is hungry. That is not sinful. The temptation is not hunger — it is satisfying a real need the wrong way. The enemy may not try to make you atheist. He may try to make you insecure. Jesus answers with Scripture:

Luke 4:4 "Man shall not live by bread alone."

Jesus refuses to let a physical need override spiritual trust.

Temptation seeks shortcuts to glory

Luke 4:7 "If you worship me (Satan), it will all be yours."

Satan offers the kingdoms without the cross, worship without suffering, & a crown without the crucifixion. Satan prefers people focused on immediate outcomes rather than eternal faithfulness. The enemy loves shortcuts.

Jesus answers with Scripture:

Luke 4:8 "Worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve."

Jesus chooses obedience over opportunity.




