

## March 31, 2024 - Resurrection Sunday!

### Stations 14 & 15: The Tomb

**John 19: 40** Taking Jesus' body, the two of them wrapped it, with the spices, in strips of linen. This was in accordance with Jewish burial customs. 41 At the place where Jesus was crucified, there was a garden, and in the garden a new tomb, in which no one had ever been laid. 42 Because it was the Jewish day of Preparation and since the tomb was nearby, they laid Jesus there.

**John 20:11** Now Mary stood outside the tomb crying. As she wept, she bent over to look into the tomb 12 and saw two angels in white, seated where Jesus' body had been, one at the head and the other at the foot. 13 They asked her, "Woman, why are you crying?" "They have taken my Lord away," she said, "and I don't know where they have put Him." 14 At this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not realize that it was Jesus.

**SO CLOSE!** The tomb is close to the site of the cross. Amid their customs and culture, the tomb was chosen for sake of convenience. What decisions in your life are driven by convenience? Are there any that you need to challenge to have a better life?

**SO CLOSE!** Mary Magdalene saw the resurrected Jesus – but did not recognize Him. Her momentary emotion kept her from grasping the monumental reality of Jesus' presence. Emotions are powerful – they serve us best when tied to reality. Are your feelings guiding your faith – or does fact guide feelings?

**SO CLOSE!** Millions of people will be in church today to hear of the Resurrection and God's Love for them. Proximity does not mean intimacy or understanding. Is your life – and our community – moving closer to God's Kingdom? What is needed for your continued growth in faith, hope, and love?
