Matthew 19–21 : Kingdom Conflicts
Jesus Confronts Worldly Views of Success

Matthew 19:23–26: "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God."

The world measures success by wealth and possessions. Jesus teaches that riches can become barriers to entering God's Kingdom when they hold our hearts. Where might wealth, comfort, or success be keeping you from fully depending on Christ?

Jesus Confronts Worldly Views of Power

Matthew 20:25–28: "Whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant... just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve."

Jesus redefines leadership through humility and sacrifice, not through control. True greatness mirrors the heart of a servant. How are you using your influence—to serve or to be served?

Jesus Confronts Worldly Expectations of Authority

Matthew 21:5 "See, your king comes to you, gentle
and riding on a donkey..."

Jesus' entry into Jerusalem defied expectations of a conquering king—He came in humility and peace. The Kingdom is not about appearance, but about righteousness. Where in your life do you need to embrace Jesus' model of humble, courageous authority?

The Kingdom of God is often in conflict with the values of this world. Jesus calls us to reject the world's standards of success, power, and authority—and embrace His way of humility, service, and surrender.
