The Gospel of Matthew

The Gospel of Matthew: "Warnings and Woes"
Matthew 22-23: Jesus warns of the dangers of re-
jecting God's invitation, and neglecting true obedi-
ence. These warnings call us to examine our hearts
as we come to the Lord's Table.

Don't Refuse the King's Invitation

Matthew 22:1-14 "For many are invited, but few
are chosen." (v. 14)

God's invitation demands a response. The Kingdom
of God is pictured as a joyful feast, but some reject
it out of indifference or pride. How have you re-
sponded to God's invitation?

Beware of Religious Hypocrisy

Matthew 23:1-12 "They do not practice what they
preach." (v. 3)

Jesus warns against the religious leaders who seek
praise but lack love. God values hearts of service,
not displays of superiority. Are you living to impress
others or to honor God?

Woes to the Unrepentant Heart

Matthew 23:13-36 (The Seven Woes) "Woe to
you... you clean the outside... but inside you are full
of greed and self-indulgence." (v. 25)

The Kingdom calls for inward transformation, not
outward performance. What areas of your life need
genuine repentance, not just appearance manage-
ment?

Jesus' warnings are rooted in His love—He wants
us to respond to His invitation, walk humbly, and
live with repentant hearts. His Table reminds us: we
didn't earn our seat. We come by grace, we come
to be made new. "Examine yourselves... and then
eat of the bread and drink of the cup." (1 Corin-
thians 11:28)
