The Lord's Model of Prayer

Matthew 6:9–13

“For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.”

The words that close the Lord's Prayer are not in the earliest Greek manuscripts we have found. It is included in the Didache, an early teaching book of the church.

The language is biblical

Scripture has many examples of praising God.

1 Chronicles 29:11 Yours, O Lord, are the greatness, the power, the glory, the victory, and the majesty; for all that is in the heavens and on the earth is yours; yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and you are exalted as head above all.

The language points to God

Prayer moves us beyond ourselves to know and trust who God is. This final line makes this prayer about God, not us. 2 Corinthians 12:9 “. . .for my power is made perfect in weakness”

The lesson of perspective

“Forever” gives us an eternal perspective. 2 Corinthians 4:17 “For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all.”
