IS YOU GOOD?

AUTHENTIC COMMUNITY ISN'T ABOUT SITTING BESIDE PEOPLE— IT'S ABOUT CARRYING THEM.

1 THESS. 2:8 • GENESIS 2:18 • ACTS 2:42-47
ACTS 4:32-35 • HEBREWS 10:24-25

① GOD'S DESIGN GENESIS. 2:18

- "It is not good for man to be alone."
- You were created for people, not just for God.
- Jesus builds a family, not an audience.

② THE EARLY CHURCH ACTS 2 / ACTS 4

- Koinonia = shared life (partnership, deep sharing)
- Devoted to teaching, prayer, meals, generosity, and each other.
- Nobody slipped through the cracks because somebody noticed.

* **KOINONIA**
PARTNERSHIP.
COMMON LIFE.
DEEP SHARING.
ALL IN.

③ CHURCH HURT IS REAL

- Church people are messy.
 - People gossip. Disappoint. Wound.
 - Deep scars often come from inside the church.
 - Jesus never wounded you—people did.
- Don't confuse Jesus with imperfect followers.

“Where everybody knows your name should be US.”

④ HEALING IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY HEB. 10:24-25

- You're not responsible for what happened.
- You are responsible for what happens next.
- Unhealed wounds lead to bitterness and isolation.
- Don't pull away... lean back into community.
