Remembrance – Week 3

Yom Kippur begins at sundown. It is the holiest day of Judaism and is a day to seek forgiveness from God. Leviticus 16 gives the original instruction to Moses.

The Day of Atonement says:

Sin is serious. (Lev. 16:2, Hebrews 9:27)

A sacrifice is necessary. (Lev. 16:15-16, Heb. 9:22)

God provides a way back into His presence. (Lev. 16:17, Heb. 10:19-22)

The cross says:

The sacrifice has come. (John 1:29)

His name is Jesus. (John 1:41)

And His work is finished. (John 19:30)

The goal of atonement isn't merely getting our sins forgiven. The goal of atonement is bringing us back into the presence of God.

Faithful Christ-followers have developed various perspectives on atonement. The scripture does not reduce the cross to a single metaphor. At the cross, Jesus took our place, paid our debt, carried our sin, defeated our enemy, revealed God's love, opened the way to God, and began a new humanity.
