“Remembering”

Leviticus 23:42-43 – “Live in temporary shelters for seven days... so your descendants will know that I had the Israelites live in temporary shelters when I brought them out of Egypt.”

Sukkot is the Jewish remembrance of God’s provision for His people in the wilderness with Moses. This year Sukkot begins on sundown Friday, September 25 and ends at sundown on Oct. 2.

The Holocaust Remembrance exhibit finishes at the USC Library on Sept 30.

Sukkot (also called the Festival of Tabernacles or Booths) may have been the same time as the Transfiguration of Jesus on the mountain (Lev. 23:34-36, Luke 9:28). Each event has eight days, Exodus, Moses, booths, mountain, cloud and divine presence.

1. Jesus did not need a tabernacle. Jesus is the tabernacle!
