“Remember”

September 2026

Psalm 77:11-12

11 I will remember the deeds of the Lord;

yes, I will remember Your miracles of long ago.

12 I will consider all Your works

and meditate on all Your mighty deeds.

Biblical remembering isn't simply looking backward. We remember what God has done so we can faithfully follow Him today. Forgetting God's faithfulness makes it easier to doubt God's goodness. **What has God done in your life that you cannot afford to forget?**

God Commands Us to Remember

Our sin nature forgets. It is a spiritual discipline to remember. God commands us to remember because what we remember shapes how we live. Jesus asks His disciples to remember Him (Luke 22:19) and the Holy Spirit reminds us (John 14:26).
