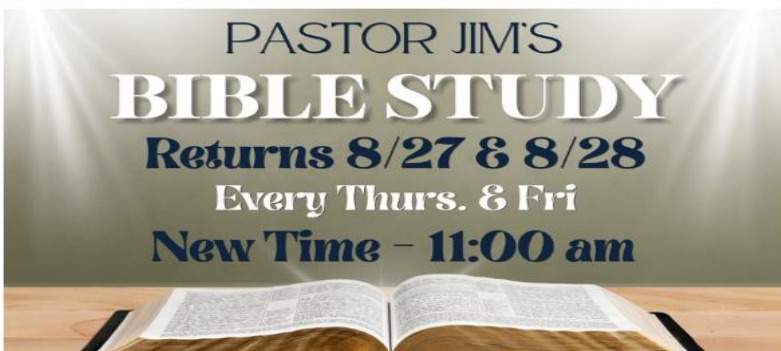

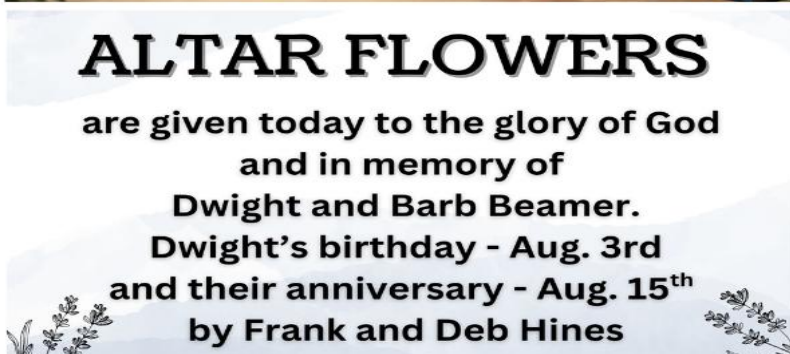

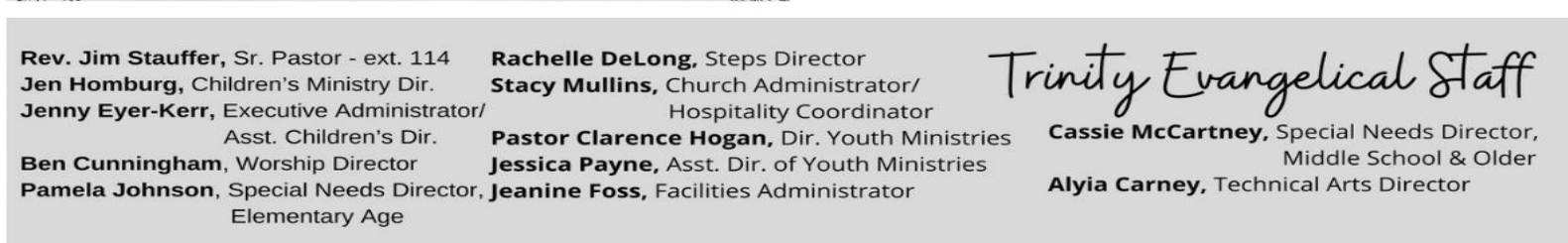

Sermon Notes: The Lord's Prayer

Matthew 6:9-13

6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

Review: Jesus teaches us to pray because on our own we do not know how to pray effectively. Prayer teaches God's relationship, eternal reign, and complete holiness. Prayer commits us to the vision of the Kingdom of God. We pray for our daily needs – both physical and spiritual.

This week: What are we praying?

Debts/Something owed – Matthew 6:12

Trespasses – Matthew 6:14/Book of Common Prayer

Sins – Luke 11:4

Bible translations should be trusted and understood. Church traditions should be valued and understood.

We pray for food and forgiveness. Verse 11 and 12 should be read as one statement. Do we see our spiritual needs as clearly as our physical one? (Matthew 5:6)

We pray for equal grace received and given. Does our forgiveness of others affect our ability to be forgiven? Jesus seems to teach that it does. (Matthew 6:14-15, 7:2, 18:21-35). Are we seeking God's grace with the same effort we are sharing that same grace with others?
