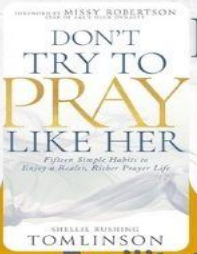

REMEMBRANCE — WEEK 2

Yom Kippur: Leviticus 23:26–32 Additional Scripture this week: Psalm 51:1–17; Isaiah 58:3–9; Luke 9:23–25;

The Jewish Calendar: The Days of Awe

The period beginning with Rosh Hashanah and culminating in Yom Kippur is traditionally called the Days of Awe or the Ten Days of Repentance. They emphasize repentance, prayer, making things right with others, and acts of righteousness.

The Sabbath falling between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur is traditionally called Shabbat Shuvah — the Sabbath of Return, drawing on the theme from Hosea 14:1.

REMEMBERING REQUIRES DENYING OURSELVES

Leviticus 23:32 “It is a sabbath of sabbath rest for you, and you must deny yourselves.”

Luke 9:23 “Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me.”

REMEMBERING SHOULD MAKE US HUMBLE

1 Corinthians 10:12 “So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall!”

Remembrance should produce humility, not complacency.

Yesterday's victory does not remove today's need for vigilance.

REMEMBERING CAN MOVE US FORWARD

Hebrews 12:1 “Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us.”
