This 9-part study will help children grow spiritually as they learn from Galatians 5:22-23. This 9-lesson study was written for elementary aged Sunday School, but can be easily adapted for any ministry setting. We have included “more than enough” with each lesson to help you adapt to every teaching situation. Use what you can to teach the main idea, even if your class time does not allow for all activities. Remember that relationships matter – children are always seeking friends. Make your classroom a place where they will build connections with their peers and with Jesus Christ.
