I'm working with volunteers to reinvigorate our Eucharistic Ministry; a team that takes communion to folks at home, in the hospital, or nursing homes. There are volunteers ready to make meals for folks who are having surgery or grieving. We are often asked “who picks the hymns and why was that hymn chosen?” by the congregation, especially when an unknown hymn has been chosen. Hymns are not randomly chosen. Sundays and Seasons (S&S) is a service to which St. Luke, as well as many ELCA congregations, subscribe to. This rich, reliable resource for worship planning offers an expansive library of content and ideas for liturgy, music, preaching, and visuals that follows the church year and the Revised Common Lectionary. S&S provides us a list of appropriate hymns to match the weekly readings. These hymns are published in the *Evangelical Lutheran Worship* (2006), *With One Voice* (1995) *All Creation Sings* (2020), and *This Far by Faith*, from Augsburg Fortress. “*This Far by Faith*” was originally conceived as a concept paper by African American Lutherans in 1990. The dream for an African American worship resource that would supplement the principal worship books of the churches continued to developed. Aided by surveys conducted among African American pastors and congregations the project moved forward and working on the book began in February 1995. Development continued through January 1998, on the weekend commemorating the birth of Martin Luther King Jr. “*This Far by Faith*” was finally published in 1999.

Income Summary

Pledged offerings for the month of December were approximately \$11.7K above the monthly budget, resulting in pledged offerings for the year being \$4030 greater than what was pledged for the year. Grace Giving for the month of December was above the monthly budget by approximately \$2.3K, and again exceeded (in addition to October and November) our typical monthly grace giving. This resulted in our total grace giving being \$1.3K below our estimated amount for the year.

With all offering sources combined, our year-end total offerings are approximately \$3.2K above our budget for the year.

Grins & Giggles income for the month of December was \$490 above the monthly budget, resulting in year-end Grins & Giggles income being \$6395 greater than the budget for the year.

We also earned \$393 in investment income in the month of December, primarily from our two Thrivent CD's.

With all budgeted income sources combined, our actual total budgeted income for the month of December was \$14.9K greater than the monthly budget, making the year-end total budgeted income \$12,428 greater than our budget for the year.

In addition to budgeted income, there was also \$4921 of unbudgeted income in the month of December. This included \$1814 from Scrip Card sales, significant donations to the Handbell and Embellish funds, and multiple smaller donations to other funds.

Treasurer's Report for December 2025

Expense Summary

Total Budgeted YTD Expenses of \$506,492.28 is less than the YTD budget of \$506,779.00 by \$286.72 as of the end of December. December budgeted expenses were less than the monthly budget by \$2058.50.

Grins & Giggles YTD Expenses of \$92,526.49 is greater than the budget of \$77,297.00 by \$5396.49, mostly due to Head Teacher salaries, resulting from the number of hours worked being greater than what was accounted for in the budget.

Net Results: As of the end of December 2025 we have an Actual YTD Total Income of \$622,084.22, and Total Expenses of \$550,318.58, resulting in a difference of \$71,765.64. A high-level year to date summary is in the table below.
