Discussion Questions

Read 2 Corinthians 9:6–8

- What stands out to you about Paul’s teaching on generosity?
- How does the promise that “**God** is able to bless you abundantly” change the way we view our resources?
- In what ways do we sometimes give reluctantly or out of pressure instead of joy? What helps cultivate cheerful giving?

Read Galatians 5:13–18

- Paul says we were called to freedom. How is *freedom* connected to *love and generosity*?
- What does it mean to “serve one another humbly in love”? What might that look like in daily life?
- How does walking by the Spirit shape the way we view our time, possessions, and resources?

Read Acts 4:32–37

- What do we learn from the early church’s approach to possessions and community?
- How does their open-handedness challenge our natural desire to hold tightly to what we have?
- What is the difference between *generosity* and *charity*?

Read Matthew 6:19–24

- Jesus talks about treasure revealing the location of our hearts. What does this mean in practical terms?
- How can we recognize when money or possessions are beginning to control us?
- What practices (habits, rhythms, disciplines) help us keep our hearts pointed toward God instead of toward wealth?

Read 1 Timothy 6:17–19

- How does giving loosen the grip of fear and anxiety about the future?
- Share about a time when giving actually *increased* your joy or strengthened your faith.
- Where might God be inviting you to loosen your grip right now – time, resources, attention, or compassion?
- What is *one practical step of generosity* you can choose this week?
- Who in your life may need encouragement, provision, or presence that you can freely give?
