CURRENT MESSAGE SERIES:

The Reason for Easter

Before celebrating the resurrection of Jesus, we must first understand the reason for His crucifixion.

March 8 – Part 1: *Eliminating the Threat*

Weeks before entering Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover, Jesus performed a miracle so powerful that it threatened to change the fabric of society. In order to preserve the peace and maintain the status quo, the Sanhedrin determined that Jesus must die.

John 11:45–50

March 15 – Part 2: *The Prophecy Fulfilled*

It was prophesied that the long-awaited true King of Israel would one day enter into the holy city of Jerusalem, riding on the back of a donkey, to be received with great fanfare. Five days prior to His crucifixion, Jesus fulfilled this prophecy. *Luke 19:37–40*

March 22 – Part 3: *The Lamb of God (Communion Service)*

Throughout their history, God had required blood sacrifices from the Israelites for the atonement of their sins. But now, at the dawn of the long-awaited "New Covenant" God Himself would provide the sacrifice. *Luke 22:14–20*

March 29 – Part 4: *Paid in Full*

What initially appeared to be a monumental failure was in fact God's greatest achievement. *John 19:28–30*

April 5 – Part 5: *The Good Shepherd*

In His sacrificial death, Jesus has proven how much He loves us. In His resurrection He has proven that every word He spoke is true.
