Listed below are the programs we offer to the community.

INSTRUCTIONAL LEAGUES

We have made the decision to continue our partnership with Upward Sports. This league will practice for one hour during the week and play games on Saturdays starting in January 2019. The emphasis for this league is on teaching skills and having fun. No score is kept.

KINDERGARTEN COED – Limit 40 players / \$85 per player

1ST/2ND GRADE GIRLS – Limit 40 players / \$85 per player

1ST GRADE BOYS – Limit 40 players / \$85 per player

2ND GRADE BOYS – Limit 40 players / \$85 per player

Player evaluations:

November 10th (11a-2p) or November 12th (6p-9p)

All players need to attend one of the evaluations! This will take 15-20 minutes per player.

TRANSITIONAL LEAGUES

This league will practice for one hour during the week and play in a 4-on-4 format for one hour on Saturdays with an emphasis on the fundamentals of team play. No score is kept.

3RD/4TH GRADE GIRLS – Limit 32 players / \$85 per player

3RD GRADE BOYS – Limit 32 players / \$85 per player

COMPETITIVE LEAGUES

This league will practice for one hour per week and play one game per week. The emphasis continues to be on teaching skills and having fun. However, score will be kept (certified officials will call the games) and teams will play in a tournament at the end of the season to determine the championship team for each league.

Teams will be built using skills assessment drills observed by coaches in each league.

Coaches will then draft players for their respective teams based on those assessments.

7TH/8TH GRADE COED -- Limit 60 players / \$105 per player ASSESSMENT: Sat. Nov 17th—10:00am in the Central Complex

HIGH SCHOOL (9-12) COED -- Limit 80 players / \$105 per player ASSESSMENT: Sat. Nov 17th—12:00pm in the Gym (FLC)

Competitive League

Assessment and Draft

4th Grade Boys, 5th/6th Grade Boys, 5th/6th Grade Girls, 7th/8th Grade Coed, High School (9th-12th) Coed

Players must be registered prior to the assessment and draft date in order to be assessed. Registrations will not be accepted on the day of the assessment/draft.

- Players will check in and be given a number to wear during the assessment.
- Coaches will have a spreadsheet with those numbers and the player names.
- Coaches must name their assistant prior to the assessment. (No more than one.)
- Players will be assessed by individually performing a 60 second drill which will include dribbling, jump shots, and layups after a warm-up/shoot around as described on the ShepNaz 60 Second Shoot Around (click on 60 Second Drill to see details).
- Additional drills (click on Additional Drills to see those drills) or pick-up games may be used for further evaluation if time allows.

Draft Procedure

- The draft will take place directly after the assessment. Players will not be present for the draft.
- Predetermined selections:
 - If only the coach has a child on the team, that team loses its 3rd round pick...this may change.
 - If only the assistant coach has a child on the team that team loses its 3rd round pick...this may change.
 - If both the head coach and the assistant coach have a child on the team the team loses its 3rd and 4th round picks...this may change.
 - If one or both coaches have multiple children, the team will lose picks always beginning in the 3rd round...this may change.
 - All registered players that did not attend the assessment will be assessed by the coaches/ShepNaz Basketball personnel and ranked based on athleticism/skill level. After the drafting of the players that attended the assessment is complete, the list of ranked registered players will be used in completing the draft. Lastly, any player that coaches/ShepNaz Basketball personnel do not know, their names will be put "in a hat" and blindly drawn and assigned to the team with the next pick.
- After the predetermined selections are made, coaches will randomly pick for draft order and will continue in "snake" fashion.
- Coaches will have 30 seconds per pick.
- If one sibling is drafted, that team is assigned both children and loses its next pick.
- Players who sign up after the assessment will be assigned to the team with the next pick.
