

Lesson 1: Forgiveness

Parents show the “**Party Pooper**” video to their kids

Scripture: Luke 17:1-4 and Matthew 6:9-15

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What does it mean to forgive someone?
- Why might forgiveness be important?
- Why might it be good that God forgives you?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 2: The Prodigal Son

Parents show the video to their kids (“**The Lost Grape**”)

Scripture: Luke 15:11-31

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What was wrong about the way the son treated his father?
- How did the son think his father would treat him when he returned?
- How did the father treat his son?
- Which of the sons is most like you?
- If the father represents God and you one of the sons, what does this story say about how God feels about you?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 3: Palm Sunday

Parents show the video to their kids (“**Palm Sunday Talk About**”)

Music Video: “King Jesus is All”

Scripture: Luke 19:28-40

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What is the job description of a king?
- In what ways is Jesus a King?
- How did the crowd respond to Jesus when he came into the city?
- How can you show that Jesus is your King?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 4: Easter Sunday

Parents show the video to their kids (“**Easter Talk About**”)

Scripture: Luke 24:1-12

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- If you went to the tomb on Easter morning, what would you expect to see?
- What would your reaction be to the news that Jesus was alive? Why?
- What difference does it make to you that Jesus is alive today?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 5: God's Will

Parents show the video to their kids (“-”)

Scripture: John 14:15-21

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- Is what God wants always the same as what you want?
- How can you know what God wants?
- How can you do what God wants?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 6: Best Friends Forever

Parents show the video to their kids (“**Best Friends Forever**”)

Scripture: 1 Samuel 20:1-17

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What are the names of some of your friends?
- What do you like to do with your friends?
- How might you be a friend to someone else?
- What might it look like for you and God to be friends?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 7: Carl's Bible

Parents show the video to their kids ("Carl's Bible")

Scripture: Acts 2:43-47

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- Who is God?
- How might you learn what God wants you to do?
- Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.
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Why might it be important to listen and do what God says?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 8: Viewpoints

Parents show the video to their kids ("**Viewpoints**")

Scripture: Exodus 20:12

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What does it mean to be honored?
- How might you honor your father and mother or grandparents?
- Why might it be important to listen and do what they say?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 9: Busy, Busy

Parents show the video to their kids (“**Busy, Busy**”)

Scripture: Exodus 20:8-11

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What are Sundays for?
- Why is that important?
- How can you also spend time with God during the week?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 10: Mini Masters

Parents show the video to their kids (“Mini Masters”)

Scripture: Exodus 20:15-17

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- Why might it be important to be honest?
- Who does cheating hurt?
- Why might it matter to God that you are honest?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 11: X-Ray

Parents show the video to their kids (“**X-Ray**”)

Scripture: John 14:15-20

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What is the Holy Spirit?
- Where is the Holy Spirit?
- Why might it be important to have the Holy Spirit in you?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 12: Melda’s Story

Parents show the video to their kids (“**Melda’s Story**”)

Scripture: Lamentations 3:22-23

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What is compassion?
- How is God compassionate toward you?
- How was God compassionate toward Melda?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 13: Bryan's Story

Parents show the video to their kids (“**Bryan's Story**”)

Scripture: Deuteronomy 31:8

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What are you afraid of?
- What can you do when you are afraid?
- What difference does it make to know that God will never leave you?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day

Lesson 14: Chex's Story

Parents show the video to their kids (“**Chex's Story**”)

Scripture: John 10:11-15

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What does a sheep do?
- How are you like a sheep?
- How does God guide you like a shepherd guides the sheep?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 15: Olivia and Elyse's Story

Parents show the video to their kids ("**Olivia and Elyse's Story**")

Scripture: Matthew 28:19-20

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What do you think is most important for someone to know about Jesus?
- How can prayer help that person believe?
- Who do you know who needs Jesus but doesn't follow him?
- How can you help that person to come to know Jesus?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 16: Noah's Ark

Parents show the video to their kids ("**Noah's Ark**")

Scripture: Genesis 9:12-16

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- Why did Noah build the ark?
- Why did the flood come?
- Why do we have rainbows?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.

Lesson 17: ZZZ

Parents show the video to their kids (“**ZZZ**”)

Scripture: Matthew 11:28-30

Parents discuss with kids how the video and scriptures relate to one another.

Ask questions such as:

- What kinds of things has God made you to do?
- What might it mean to take God’s “yoke” on you?
- How might you find rest for your soul?

Then, pray together about the lesson for the day.
