Service

The towel is the symbol of Service – as evidenced by Jesus washing the feet of his disciples (Jn. 13). Jesus completely redefines leadership and the lines of authority. As we move into a servant mindset, the grace of humility is worked into our lives as we realize our total dependence on God. We become available and vulnerable to do the work God calls us to do.

Consider the following ways to serve this week:

- **Serve in hiddenness.** Do an act of service anonymously to rebuke the flesh and deal a blow to pride.
- **Serve in guarding the reputation of others.** Daily we are exposed to reputation breaking, gossipy language. “Speak evil of no one.” (Titus 3:2a) Resolve to not join others in slanderous talk.
- **Serve in common courtesy.** “Show perfect courtesy to all people.” (Titus 3:2b) Engage others through a smile, saying “please” and “thank-you”, holding doors, and being present to others in small talk. These are simple ways to acknowledge others and affirm their worth.
