#### **Samaritas to Assist Ukrainian Refugees**

Samaritas, the former Lutheran Social Services of Michigan, has a long history of helping refugees settle in Michigan. The Director of New American Services, Mihaela Mitrofan, traveled to the Ukraine recently to help out and has some information to share. She points out that refugees are not traveling through other countries, and it could be weeks or months for some to make it to Michigan.
