Mark 14.3-9

Her worship was a declaration of her faith (He *is* the Messiah – the anointed one)

Personal

- Personal worship of the Personal God
 - Personal worship: There are no observers – worship is a participation event (evaluate or engage, expectations or anticipation)
 - Personal God: He is not who we want Him to be or wish He was
 - He's not the God of "don't judge because God is love"
 - He's not Jesus draped in an American flag
 - He's not the God who exists to make your life better

Extravagant

- Those who experience grace deeply express their passion loudly
 - It will make others uncomfortable (not annoyed – uncomfortable)
 - It will outlast you (because worship forms us and others – repercussions in relationships ripple for generations TOM JORDAN)

Sacrificial

- Costly but not wasteful
 - My declaration of faith in my worship of Jesus cannot and will not be defined or deterred by the indignant response of the ignorant or the pretenders
 - Note the brokenness: willingness to break what was valuable and offer that brokenness to Jesus
 - Some don't want to bring broken things to Jesus (not an imperfect sacrifice, not laziness) SHELLS – Psalm 51.17 – "Beautiful thing"
