Small Group Questions

During the sermon, Josh (From GUM) mentioned a statement:

“the New Testament describes the church as a people formed by the cross. It is a journey with a cost”.^[1] (Mission Leadership)

- What do you think about this statement? Agree/Disagree? Do you feel that this is how you live your life or understand what the church is?

Don't stop at your tears: Josh mentioned that he believes to many people have stopped at tears. What breaks your heart and drives you to action?

When (if ever) have you cried because you were so burdened for someone/a people? Are you burdened for the city?

- What is currently happening in our city that is pushing us to pray for it, engage in it, and be proactive.

Who has God put on your heart?

- Missionaries are often asked, who is your people group or who has God called you to? --- Local or Globally- homeless, youth, children, prisoners, prostitutes,, etc? If you know who your people group is, What have you done or doing to engage this group? If you do not know, let this be the place where you ask God to burden your heart for a people.
- The best way to minister to others is through your God given talents (chess, finance, games, laughter, etc) but you have to be there to allow your gifts to be used.
