

### Financial Corner: End of Year Contributions to RLC

The end of the year is a great time to prayerfully consider giving to support RLC's ministry.

Some context: This year's tithing projection is \$1,050,000, a 4.5% increase over last year's budget. Our average weekly worship attendance (AWWA) is around 350 worshippers at the early and late Sunday services, Wiggle Church, and Brandermill. Praise God! Our yearly tithing projection averages \$3,000 per worshipper (\$60/week). We are a congregation blessed with a great mix of singles, students, young families, empty nesters, and retirees. Everyone's financial circumstances are different; we do not all have the same capacity to give. And yet God asks us all to give sacrificially according to our means. Praise God we all join together in this ministry to advance His work.

### How can I give?

In addition to offering envelopes, there are several additional tools available to support Redeemer's ministry and, depending on circumstances, possibly reduce your tax liability. (Disclaimer: this does not constitute tax advice; consult your tax professional for your specific circumstances.)

### 1. Scheduled Contributions

Your bank website likely has a "Bill pay" or "Pay bills" option, which can be used to schedule onetime or recurring payments from your checking account. You can schedule a check to be cut and mailed to the church in the amount of your monthly contribution. Simply add "Redeemer Lutheran Church" as a company/payee, then use your envelope number as your account number to make sure your contribution is accredited to you for tax purposes.

### 2. Donate appreciated stocks/ETFs tax-free

You may own stocks or ETFs in an individual or jointly held taxable account. With the markets having a great run recently (over 100% gain in the last 10 years), you may have some highly appreciated assets. Typically, selling these assets will incur a capital gains tax on the increase in value. However, you can donate these assets directly to Redeemer without incurring a tax liability for yourself or the church. (For example: if you want to contribute \$10,000 and you have a stock which has increased by 100%. To get \$10,000 cash, you may have to sell \$12,000 of stock, with \$2,000 going to capital gains taxes. Donating \$10k of stock directly to the church gives \$10,000 to the ministry and avoids any tax liability for you or the church.)

Redeemer has an account at Vanguard. Your brokerage company will have forms to help you "gift shares" to this account, from Vanguard, Fidelity, or whatever firm you are using. Here is information needed to originate the gifting action: Name of receiving firm: Vanguard

### 3. Required Minimum Distributions from retirement accounts (RMD)

For those of us who are 73 years of age or older and have a traditional retirement account (IRA, SEP IRA, Simple IRA, 401(k), or 403(b)), you are required to withdraw a percentage of your account every year, called a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD). (Your brokerage firm will calculate the amount for you.) This is a taxable event, but you can avoid taxes on some or all of the distribution by donating it directly to Redeemer through a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD). All RMD funds have to originate from a cash fund, so prior to any RMD action, you may need to convert some assets to cash. Once that cash is in place, you direct the brokerage firm (they have a process for this) to use some or all of the required distribution as a charitable distribution. You'll need to input Redeemer's name and address. The brokerage firm may send the check directly to the church, or it may be mailed to you in the name of the church, to be forwarded by you to the office. Redeemer Lutheran Church, 9400 Redbridge Road, North Chesterfield, VA 23236 It is not as complicated as it sounds, the brokerage firms do this regularly, and the process is in a seamless workflow.


### 4. Planned Giving Initiative (PGI)


