2 Samuel 6:14-22 *“Wearing a linen ephod, David was dancing before the Lord with all his might...when (David’s wife) saw King David leaping and dancing before the Lord, she despised him in her heart...I will celebrate before the Lord. I will become even more undignified than this, and I will be humiliated in my own eyes...”*

Proverbs 8:13 (God) *“...I hate pride and arrogance...”*
