- Submit your story as soon as possible after your event. Articles as late as one month past the event may not be accepted.
- All submissions are subject to the approval of the web editor and/or pastor.
- All submissions will be edited for grammar, content, style and length. To maximize readership, articles should be as brief as possible while including complete information. While exceptions may be made, articles should be limited to 250 words or less.
- Every submission must be accompanied by the name and contact information of the author. If an article invites readers to seek more information, complete information for that contact must be included in the article.
- Each submission should be tied to the mission of the church: To make new disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.
- We're looking for stories about events that have already occurred. For articles of upcoming events, contact the church office for the inclusion in the digital newsletter, What's Happening.
- Photos are welcome to accompany the articles. Photos will run in a cycle and will eventually be replaced with more recent events.
- Any submission is subject to later use in other CUMC publications, both print and electronic.
