WHY THIS YEAR'S 40 DAYS FOR LIFE CAMPAIGN WAS SO SIGNIFICANT

This year's 40 Days for Life campaign was significant for many reasons. Here are a few.

First, I was the first Protestant to manage a 40 Days for Life campaign in the eight years that St. Petersburg has hosted campaigns.

Second, we were able to invite hundreds of Protestant churches in St. Petersburg, and six of them came out to the sidewalk with us. Several are interested in learning more about sidewalk counseling.

Third, the unity that the pro-life movement has experienced here in St. Petersburg has never been stronger.

Fourth, I was able to be at the clinic for 34 of the 40 Days of the campaign. I was happy to add these days to my ministry responsibilities.

THE STORY OF A SAVE (reprinted)

We have some new subscribers, so I am reprinting the story of our last save in April !

“This past April 1st, was a normal Saturday morning. We arrived at the clinic about 8:30 a.m. as usual and began praying with our team. Cars began to enter the parking lot. Women began to enter the clinic.

We approached them gently and called out to each one. “We have information for you. Make sure you read this information before you go inside.” No one came over to get the information, which contained the names of organizations locally that help women and men involved in crisis pregnancies.

We continued to pray. A few minutes later an SUV pulled in the parking lot. We walked over next to the vehicle and waited, praying. No one got out of the car for at least 15 minutes. The car kept running. We kept praying.

Eventually a woman got out of the car. She walked toward me. As I was getting ready to offer her the information, she spoke. “We can’t go through with this. We’re so glad you’re here.”

We talked some more and prayed for Britney and her friend Gail whom she had brought to the clinic. They had been “on the fence” about the abortion the entire drive there. They live about 45 minutes away from St. Petersburg. I gave them the information and referred them to a pregnancy center in Bradenton.

The baby should be born around Christmas Day.

A Florida late-term abortionist who was arrested in South Carolina in 2015 on drug charges pleaded guilty this week and has been sentenced to five years’ probation and over \$26,000 in fines.

James Pendergraft, who is known for his ownership of several abortion facilities in Florida, pleaded guilty on Monday to ten criminal counts, including possession of a controlled substance, possession of marijuana, possession or distribution of prescription drugs without a prescription, and manufacturing or possession of Schedule I & II substances.

According to the Ocala Star Banner and Operation Rescue, as well as court records, he was sentenced to varying punishments—depending on the crime—including jail time of up to five years. However, the time behind bars was suspended and Pendergraft was placed on five years probation. He is also required to pay a cumulative fine of \$26,342.25.

Pendergraft owns four abortion clinics in Orlando, his jail time could significantly affect the abortion cartel there! Pray!

SUPPORT UPDATE AND PRAYER REQUESTS

1. We are at 78% of full-time support. We need approximately \$1300 in monthly support commitments.
2. We need more people to come out to the sidewalks, especially during the week. Pray that I can recruit these folks and that they would come out with consistency.
3. Pray specifically for the closing of the clinics on Central Avenue in St Petersburg and on 66th St N in St Petersburg. The Central Avenue clinic is the main place where FPR does our ministry work, but have begun ministering on Wednesdays and Fridays too.
4. Pray for the involvement of more local churches in St Petersburg. I had good interactions with many of them during 40 Days for Life and am hopeful this can turn into a good working relationship in 2018.
5. Pray for some new attendees to the sidewalk counseling classes that I will schedule soon.
6. Pray for the salvation of clinic workers, staff and the doctors in St Petersburg's three clinics.
7. Pray for more participation in our "Defending Pro-Life classes" beginning this spring.
8. Pray for continued health and strength for Rebecca, our girls, and me.
9. Pray for more exposure for FPR as we seek the raise the pro-life profile here in St Petersburg.
