
2023 Women of the ELCA Triennial Gathering Planning has



This month's pastor message asks for responses to these questions:


What does faith formation mean?

Pastor's Report: Pastor will be submitting her report for June and July.

Old Business - Updates by Rhoda.....specific council members are still working on addressing the internet issues we have with live streaming and WIFI service.....Parish Directory is moving along and people are signing up.....Vacation Bible School (VBS) will be held August 14 to 17, with some students signed up and there was discussion about this event.

New Business - Luther Point Bible Camp (LPBC) - Rhoda presented info. from Jackie Kurkowski that LPBC is in need of picnic tables/benches. Jackie will get estimates and more information.

Bryn presented information about a group of musically minded people from the Joint Parish that have met and are making plans for future music for both parishes.

Holy Fork in the Road, phase two: (Missional agenda) Rhoda and Marty led council in the second discussion of the "Holy Fork in the Road: from Worry to Wonder" presentation which was shown at the Spring Synod Assembly. This conversation is meant for the entire congregation as we continue throughout the year, with more information in monthly newsletters. Rhoda will check with Bethany Council to see where they are at. In August we will be looking at the next two steps.

Visitation Ministry Discussions Begin

On Sunday July 9, 2023 Rick K., Donna T, Frank, Wanda, and Mary R. attended the meeting led by Pr. Emily. They discussed:

-the congregational mission to be the hands and feet of God in our community — would there be interest in starting a lay visitation ministry?

-Stephen Ministry (a popular org that helps congregations with visitation ministries). Discussed wanting to start small now, but if a core group of "visitors" or "eucharist ministers" "table servers" "extending the table?" (name TBD) comes together they can look into Stephen's Ministry. SM is a big process/commitment.

-The shelf above the sink in sacristy is where all the consecrated elements go—so the basket with the pre-filled wine/wafer OR the wafers in the ciborium are available <u>any time</u> for any visit. We need to discuss in the future the rite visitors would use with those they are visiting; responsibilities of the pastor vs. these ministers; overview of eucharist in general.

-If ppl seem interested, we will have a separate meeting to discuss the nuts and bolts of how a typical visit will go; how to manage visits/lists.

Pilgrim was scheduled to meet on July 12, 2023 but no one showed. However, vocal interest suggests that Pilgrim is interested in doing something like this. An end goal is to have the visitation ministry be parish-wide and not separated between the churches.

Next Steps: prepare visitation list and send them letter letting them known (after council okays the ministry). Then, we divvy up visits and have an hour meeting to go over how to do a visitation.

If you are interested in participating in visitation ministry please talk to Pastor Emily, Donna Tjader/Pres. Rick Kosloski (Bethany) or Carol Thompson (Pilgrim).
