

### **Discussion Only Talking Points**

\*These are just discussion points for the time being, no decisions are being made on the following:

**Financial Discussion**: to use some of the Thrivent Trust funds to help with our deficit by repaying the general fund for the mission money that has been spent by the church over the past number of years that should have been taken out of that fund, close Youth and Family Checking account and put money into general fund, Absorb some of the funds from the church clubs.

Financial Charts have been made to show the decline in our annual giving at the church.

Discussion was tabled until the August meeting and then possible solutions will be presented to the church congregation.

\*Discussion are still ongoing for the possibility of upgrading to a digital sign for the front of the church parking lot.

### To the members of Bethany,

The council (and other congregation members) have been motivated to obtain an LED sign for the front of the church. At our council meeting on Tues. July 11<sup>th</sup>, we decided to ask Jane Wilcox's niece if we could use part of the money Jane left to the church to purchase a sign.

Pam, Jane's niece, called us back on Monday the following week to say that whatever we thought was an appropriate use of the money was ok with her. She reiterated several times that Jane was community minded (as evidenced by her service to the Lioness club) and that she thought this was a great way to commemorate Jane. We cannot advertise all that is happening with our present sign. We also stated that we are in a prime location for locals and tourists to read what would be posted on our sign. An event center just opened less than a block from Bethany, which will bring many more people right past our church. Research has shown that 80% of advertising comes from such a sign. This is what the younger generation will pay attention to.

So, with Pam's blessing on behalf of the Wilcox family, we will begin our search for a provider of the sign. We will get about 3 bids and focus on quality and ease of service should something need attention. These are the two things that Pam emphasized.

We are excited to share this news with you! Bethany has so much to offer, and now we can share it even more effectively with both the community and visitors to Siren.
