Pastor Message February 2024 Dear Parish,

Calendars. Time. These two things govern our lives. As Steve Jobs said, "My favorite things in life don't cost any money. It's really clear that the most precious resource we all have is time." Who wouldn't follow this insanely rich, genius businessman, highly successful founder of Apple, Inc.? Our Lord and Savior teaches us in Matthew's gospel "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." Do we follow a human-god like Steve Jobs or Jesus, the God-man, who tells us that to be rich you must be poor?

We have a goofy year set before us. The confusion of having Christmas Eve on a Sunday to this being a leap-year and, most pressing, is Easter's early arrival. Easter is always the Sunday after the first full-moon after the spring equinox (meaning March 22nd is the earliest possible date for Easter Sunday). Easter Sunday this year is March 31st. As we prepare our schedules, routines, and future plans I encourage us to hold central our life together in Christ. Make your faith formation and church a priority.
