Sharing the Faith: A Community of Koinonia

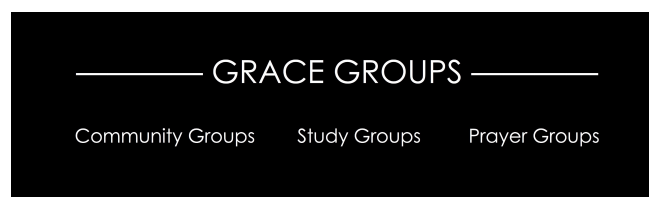

1. What does Philemon have to deal with if he forgives the runaway slave, Onesimus?
2. What does Paul mean in verse 6 by "sharing the faith"?
3. Why is Paul in prison?
4. How does Paul convince Philemon to forgive Onesimus?

Paul tells Philemon in verse 11 that Onesimus is returning to him and will now be very useful to him. In what ways would he be useful to Philemon now that he is a Christian? (Hint: verses 15&16)
