To Do

Say: The first people who followed Jesus were called the early church. They were like a big family. They ate together, prayed together, and helped each other everywhere they went! Let's play a pizza game to show some of the different ways they did that!

- 1. Whisper an "Early Church Action" printed on the back of this guide to a kid who wants a turn to act.
- 2. Kid acts out action without using words or sounds.
- 3. Other kids **guess** what they're acting out. *Give hints if* kids run out of guesses.
- 4. When the right answer is guessed, the kid actor adds 4 toppings of their choice to the pizza.

Say: This pizza reminds me of the early church. Each of us might choose different toppings for it, but it's still one pizza. It reminds me how everyone in the early church helped in different ways, but they were all part of one family: God's family, the Church!

5. Repeat steps 1-4, with new kids as time allows. Move on to "More Wavs to Share Jesus Everywhere We Go Today!" if you complete all early church actions.

- When you follow Jesus, you are a part of God's family, the Church. What can the people in God's family do to make it *feel* like we're all one family?
- What are some ways you can show God's love during the week-not just here inside the church building, but out in the world?

Wrap Up

- Prav together.
- Do the small group activity again or play a game like Rock, Paper, Scissors or I Spy.

Leader Tip

End with encouragement. Try to encourage each student with something specific about them before they leave.

After Activity

Kids Keep	Nothing
You Keep	Jar of pickle cards (save to reuse)

To Do

IF NOT ALREADY DONE BEFORE ACTIVITY STARTS:

Separate pickle cards along perforations to make pickle card set. Place cards inside plastic jar and reseal lid.

Say: When someone has a problem, you could say they're in a pickle! Followers of Jesus use what they have to help people out of a pickle. Let's play a game where you'll have to help someone out of a pickle.

- 1. Seat kids in a circle.
- 2. Give pickle jar to one kid and turn around.
- 3. Kids pass pickle jar around circle while chanting, "Pickle problem, pickle problem!"
- 4. At any random time you choose, turn toward group and say, "Pick a problem!"
- 5. Kid holding jar opens it, pulls out a card, and reads the problem printed on it to the group. Kids can hand it to you to read if they want help.
- 6. Group **discusses** ways to help and kid **says** what they'd do to help. See back of guide for ideas.
- 7. Repeat steps 2-6 as time allows. See back for more!

- In the Bible story, Jesus fed 5,000 people with one little boy's lunch. What does that show us about what God can do with the small things we share?

Wrap Up

- Pray together.
- **Do** the small group activity again or play a game like Thumb Wars or Telephone.

Leader Tip

Don't forget to notice the quiet kids. Try drawing them in with a question or even a helping role for your group.

OPTIONAL HELP BEFORE ACTIVITY TIME STARTS:

Scan QR code on back of this guide to watch this fun game in action.

Say: People who follow Jesus work together to make sure everyone feels welcomed and loved in church. As a part of God's family, the Church, we work together to meet people's needs, too. Let's play a game where we'll team up and work together!

1. Prepare kids for game:

- Give kids a sheet of cardstock. Help them fold it lengthwise and open it back up slightly to create a V-shaped half-tube.
- Move group to one end of your room. NOTE: All groups should start on the same wall for this game.

Say: Let's pretend this ping pong ball is a person who's stuck here. Let's pretend there's a church at the other side of our room—all the way to that wall! (Point to opposite wall.) Let's work together to get them all the way over there, using only our paper V's!

Leader Tip

Remember to pray with your kids, not just for them. It models a real relationship with God. And it's powerful!

- 1. Kids **line up** perpendicular to the starting wall, so their line is extending toward your "finish" wall.
- 2. Kids **line up** their paper V's with each other, with each paper V overlapping slightly. This will create a "half-pipe" for the ball to run through.
- 3. Place ping pong ball in the paper V closest to the wall.
- 4. Kid **tilts** their paper V slightly so the ball rolls into the next person's paper V.
- 5. When the ball has left the first kid's paper V, they **rush** to the other end of the line to **extend** the half-pipe.
- 6. Gameplay **continues** with kids tilting their paper V's to let the ball roll to the next kid, then rushing to the other end of the line to extend the half-pipe.
- 7. If the ball drops, pick it up and **continue** from where it dropped.
- 8. **Continue** this relay until the ball reaches the "finish" wall. You have gotten the ping pong ball "person" safely to "church!"
- 9. If time allows, reset and play again!
- 10. If your group needs an extra **challenge**, have them return to start each time the ball drops.
